Training Overview

The Child Welfare Attorney Trial Techniques Training, a Georgia specific, “learning-by-doing” trial techniques training, will be held June 18-20, 2010, at the Emory University School of Law. **Enrollment is limited to 60 attorneys**. A waitlist will be employed to ensure an optimal faculty-student ratio.

The training offers a full year’s MCLE credit (12 MCLE hours, including 1 ethics hour, 6 trial practice hours and 1 optional self-report professionalism hour).

No payment is due with your application form. ICLE Registration forms will be mailed to the first 60 accepted applicant and a waitlist will be maintained. Submit your payment to the Institute of Continuing Legal Education (ICLE) with your ICLE registration form.

Registration Fee (Payable to ICLE): **\$60** for GACC Members, **\$100** for Non-GACC Members (12-month GACC membership included with your registration)
