On or about [REDACTED] law enforcement was called to the residence in the [REDACTED] for a domestic violence incident. The child [REDACTED] reported fighting between the mother and her husband [REDACTED]. The mother was found by police to be badly beaten with two black eyes, a broken nose, and bruises and marks around her neck. The mother's broken nose resulted in a large amount of blood across the house. The domestic violence incident occurred in front of the child and the child reported fighting frequently. The child has reportedly missed over a month of school, which resulted in he mother being arrested for truancy warrants.
